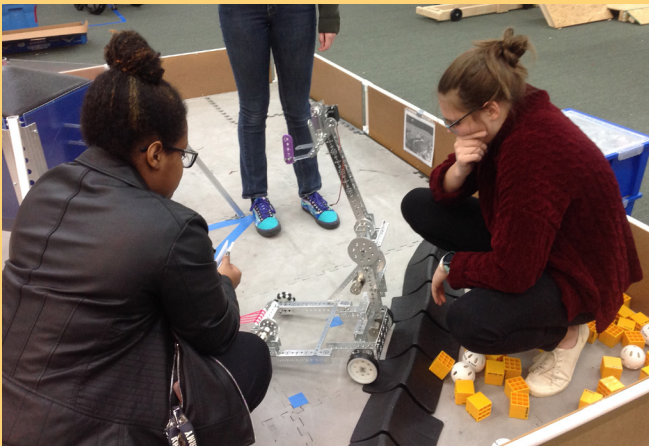

## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is the length of the summer programs?

The program runs for one week. Because we have a fixed counselor/camper ratio, we cannot accommodate a single-day booking. Campers must be enrolled for the full week.

### What is the counselor/camper ratio?

1 to 7 ratio

### Is space limited?

Space is limited by grade level. We will do our best to accommodate as many children as possible. If a grade slot is full, your child may be placed on a waiting list. Please register early to improve your chance for admission.

### When do I register and pay?

Online registration begins February 8. After registering, an email confirmation will be sent within three business days. If space is available, the email will include payment details and camp forms that must be completed to finalize the registration process. If space is unavailable, your child may be placed on a waiting list in case a slot opens up.

### What do campers need to bring and wear?

Campers need to bring a bagged lunch. They need to wear athletic shoes and comfortable clothing that is easy to move in. Some activities may involve campers getting dirty or wet.

### Is other food provided?

We will make theme-related treats to enjoy along with the lunch that campers bring from home.

### What is the cancellation policy?

Requests for cancellations and refunds must be made by May 24, 2019. No refunds will be made after that date.
